NETWORK EARTH STATION LICENCE – 313120

ISSUED TO EXCELERATE FROM OFCOM FOR SECTOR/CLASS/PRODUCT 308010

Bullet points regarding licence conditions.

1) Under the terms of the licence the specific frequencies and power levels operated by Excelerate's VSAT customers allows Excelerate to operate an unlimited number of VSAT terminals within the scope and cost of the licence.

“**VSAT Network licenses** (Ofcom speak for the above) allow the holder to deploy terminals below 50 dBW across the UK at will, without the intervention of Ofcom; except in the two identified areas (as highlighted in your licence document) or within MoD or CAA installations/property. The operational frequency of use for the network is 14000MHZ to 14250MHZ only. Terminals above 50dBW can be cleared by Ofcom and are assessed on a case by case basis, subject to a £200 fee chargeable per terminal”

2) All customers' sites fixed, transportable or portable can be deployed without prior notice or approval from Ofcom with the exception of two sites within a 5 Kilometre radius of RAF Station Menwith Hill, Yorkshire and GCHQ Bude in Cornwall. Any customer wishing to deploy an Excelerate licensed VSAT terminal within the perimeter fence of any airport must seek the permission of the CAA or the Airport Operator in order to do so. In the case of Emergency Services it would be prudent to seek this permission collectively from the airports within their operational regions in advance of any incident. A full list of airports and contact numbers is included in Excelerate's licence appendices.

3) It is a condition of the licence that Excelerate disable any terminal which infringes its licence or causes interference with other users or apparatus as a result of malfunction or abuse.
